2018 Woodland Theatre

Update: If you have driven by the Woodland Theatre in Kettle Falls recently, you were likely amazed by the transformation. Our funky little theater has emerged as the professional, classy venue we know it to be. Thanks to countless hours of hard work by Andrew and volunteers, we now have the lower half of the facade looking close to our concept of what it should be. The old barn boards were removed, single pane windows replaced, framing constructed for the new Vinson Grant signs, the entry stairs and railings were replaced, and the exterior has a new stucco finish. And we're not done!



A newly manufactured framework and railing system is now in place over the side handicap entrance thanks to Inland Empire Health Foundation along with funds and volunteer hours from our many donors and members.

The grant committee is putting the final touches on an additional grant request that will allow us to complete the stucco, re-roof the front of the theatre with better drainage and install a lighted neon tower with the theater name. The picture above shows the new and the future of the theatre facade.

In addition, the State Capitol budget finally passed in January and Woodland will now be able to contract with the WA State Heritage Capital Fund for some much needed work to the back of the theater building including replacing badly deteriorated stucco, enclosing soffits, gable ends and enclosing the porch for secure storage. As funds for this work will be reimbursed months from now, all the payments for this project will need to first come from our existing bank account. Thankfully, the Friends of Woodland Theatre, our major donors and sustaining donors are generous and continue to support these many improvements.
