The next show will be on March 30 & 31 but WHAT should we show then and in the future? What classic films would you like to see, what handsome star, or alluring starlet would you like to lay eyes on? What movies would you like to bring your family to? First choice of course would be public domain films (research online) with no royalties but, others will be considered too.
