This envelope with a new roof, on a new foundation will allow for an expanded, remodeled back stage in the future. Grant assistance from the WA State Heritage Capital Fund is a big part of this restoration project. We would like to thank a fabulous work crew of Jerry Voelker, Tom Drake, Dave Jones, David King, Byron Kerner and Peggy Townley who assisted Andrew Urbaniak in the foundation backfill. Work on the upper façade parapet, on the front of the building, will be visible soon, wiring and supporting structures are now in place, thanks in part to an Innovia Grant!
