

**Capital Campaign Phase Three 2025—2029** is well underway. During the first two weeks of January Foust Fabrication installed seven rods to stabilize the bowed walls of our auditorium. You will probably notice the two closest to the stage. New flashing over the outside beams will complete the project. This strengthening of the walls prepares the building for a heavier, stronger roof to replace our 50-year-old open-air gable roof.



Baldwin Signs of Spokane has plans for a new historic-looking tower that will emerge this spring. The Colville Vinson fund is currently considering a proposal for an LED compatible light board as the first part of a transition to full LED stage lighting.

Funding for the rod installation includes a \$10,000 donation from Innovia Foundation toward the expected \$40,000 cost. The tower cost will be \$25,000 with \$10,000 donated by Jim and Eden Davidson of Danville. The remaining costs will come from Major Donors, Friends of Woodland Theatre and a small Community Accelerator grant.



**All costs for these projects will become matching funds for the new roof.**
